Internationales Perspectives of migrations Report released by OECD

An asset for rich countries

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USPA NEWS - The OECD is organizing a conference on the theme "Migration, an opportunity for OECD countries" on September 16 at a press workshop, animated by Françoise Crouigneau, Vice President of AJEF. The 450 page report was issued that day for the press and professionals, Angel Gurría, OECD Chairman.

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The 30 journalists, around Jean-Christophe Dumont, Head of the Division of International Migration, OECD and Stefano Scarpetta, Director of the Directorate for Employment, Labour and Social Affairs, OECD to decrypting embargoed "International Migration Outlook" to be presented by the Secretary General of the OECD Angel Gurría, the United Nations, during the high-level meeting to address the mass movements of refugees and migrants and the leaders Summit on refugees Monday and Tuesday 19/20 September.
